Events and Cases Roll while Education Remains Key

"The man who does not read has no advantage over the man who cannot read." ~ Mark Twain

Samuel Clements' (Mark Twain) famous quote applies to the issue of education as well. The only way people will try HDPE pipe is if they learn about it first; that is to say become educated on the product. And, as Clements says, we have to make the effort to read and learn. That is our mantra at the PE Pipe



Alliance and that is our mission. We educate, demonstrate and then assist municipal leaders and consulting engineers regarding who to go to for information, why to use a technique or a product in a certain circumstance, what design principles are necessary, and how to use HDPE pipe, fittings and equipment.

In 2016, The Alliance Team of 85 men and women conducted 50 events all across the United States. We visited 23 states and saw over 3,300 people face to face. We worked on over 110 different new leads and saw at least 40 projects go in the ground. We were busy, but not half as busy as we will be in the years ahead as HDPE continues to assert itself in the municipal water market.

We can learn a lot from projects going in ground. 2016 saw the largest and longest directional drill on record in the Miami Beach Water System. The famous 54" HDPE South Beach Force Main Drill job is now operational. GC

Mancini Brothers managed two drills totaling 4350' that went through bedrock with only 5 months of construction time. The design build job saved the City \$3.5 million and is helping rehab their 100 year old system. Check out the drone project video from our friend David Mancini.



Aquarion Water Company operating in Connecticut, Massachusetts and New Hampshire is the largest investor-owned water utility in New England. Tired of the same old break and fix break and fix routine with ductile iron, they sampled HDPE and learned that it is not only less expensive, it is easier to install and it can provide better service levels than traditional pipe types.

In Lago Vista, Texas, water utility manager, David Stewart is converting his entire system to HDPE over time. He has seen water loss rates drop from 35% to 13% in 7 short years. The suburb of Austin is the envy of many other cities throughout Texas that have not yet taken advantage of HDPE. You can watch a video on the city's use here.





At the sacred National Landmark, Arlington National Cemetery, HDPE pipe saved the day and provided a low cost and most importantly, a less intrusive alternative to open cut. Failing metal pipes were fractured with pipe bursting equipment and HDPE pipe was pulled in. Murphy Pipelines respected the existing

graves and scores of funerals that occurred during the contract and the entire trenchless process enlightened many at the Army Corps of Engineers. Thanks to Murphy Pipelines for a job well done. Check out the project video here.

In other areas of the country however, water loss is not a concern but breakage rates and the cost to fix them is. In East Windsor NJ, Water Chief Richard Brand (East Windsor MUA) will no longer allow other materials in his system after becoming fed up with young ductile iron pipe failures in his hot soils.
